

MAJOR ACCIDENT PREVENTION POLICY

Kordsa Technical Textile Inc. recognizes the protection of human life, the environment, and company assets as its highest priority across all its operations. In line with this commitment, the Company undertakes to fully comply with national legislation and international standards in order to prevent major industrial accidents arising from its processes and to minimize their consequences.

Within the framework of its sustainability and operational excellence approach, Kordsa adopts the following principles:

- **Risk Management and Preventive Approach**

Systematically identifies, assesses, and controls existing and potential hazards in all operations, reducing risks to acceptable levels.

Adopts a proactive risk management approach aimed at preventing major industrial accidents before they occur.

- **Safety Management System**

Establishes, implements, and maintains a Major Accident Prevention Safety Management System in compliance with the Seveso III Directive and international best practices.

Integrates this system with ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System and ISO 14001 Environmental Management System.

- **Legal Compliance and International Standards**

Ensures full compliance with all applicable national legislation, international regulations, and industry best practices in all activities.

- **Operational Controls and Process Safety**

Implements safe operating procedures for all processes, including normal, abnormal, and emergency operations.

Develops systematic approaches to control risks during maintenance, repair, shutdown, and commissioning activities.

- **Emergency Management and Preparedness**

Identifies major industrial accident scenarios and prepares comprehensive emergency response plans accordingly.

Conducts regular emergency drills to test preparedness and continuously improve response capability.

- **Training, Awareness, and Safety Culture**

Organizes regular training programs for employees, contractors, and all relevant stakeholders.

Promotes continuous awareness activities to establish and strengthen a positive safety culture.

- **Management of Change**

Manages changes related to facilities, processes, equipment, or organizational structures through a systematic Management of Change (MoC) process.

Evaluates and documents the risk impacts of all changes before implementation.

- **Provision of Resources**

Provides the necessary human resources, technology, and financial resources to ensure safe and sustainable operations.

- **Continuous Improvement and Auditing**

Regularly monitors and audits performance and continuously improves the system through management reviews.

Enhances management systems based on incident investigations and lessons learned.

- **Stakeholder Engagement and Transparency**

Encourages the participation of employees, contractors, and other stakeholders by considering their opinions in decision-making processes.

Ensures that this policy is effectively communicated to all relevant stakeholders.
